	The consultant's audited financial statements, stamped "received" by the BIR or its duly accredited and authorized institutions, which comprise the statements of financial position as of December 31, 2020 and 2021, showing among others the total and current assets and liabilities.

Under BIR Revenue Memorandum Circular No. 49-20201 dated May 20, 2020 Taxpayers may opt to submit 2019 Income Tax Return and required attachments online through the eAFS system of the BIR.

Further, the BIR clarified the use of eAFS system in its Revenue Memorandum Circular No. 40-2022 dated March 4, 2022, which states that:

In order to provide ease to taxpayers, the submission of eFiled Annual Income Tax Returns (AITR) and its attachments to eAFS is applicable to any taxable year and all succeeding fiscal and/or taxable years. The existing procedures on the submission of filed AITR and its attachments to eAFS system shall be observed.
