NEW SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL LICENSE WITH EXTENDED VALIDITY PERIOD AND LICENSES INCORPORATING AUTHORIZATION TO TRANSPORT RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 6 OF THE CODE OF PNRI REGULATIONS (CPR) PART 22 REV. 2

WHEREAS, the Philippine Nuclear Research Institute (PNRI) hereinafter referred to as PNRI is mandated by Republic Act No. 2067, as amended, and Republic Act No. 5207, as amended, to establish and issue regulations and orders with respect to atomic energy facilities and materials for the protection of the health and safety of the workers and of the general public; and for this purpose the regulations are codified in the Code of PNRI Regulations (CPR);

WHEREAS, Republic Act 5207 Section 4(k) authorizes the PNRI to charge and collect reasonable fees in connection with its licensing and regulatory functions, provided that such fees shall be imposed by regulation on the basis of such published criteria as the PNRI deems appropriate, taking into consideration, among other criteria, the nature of the activity licensed and regulated;

WHEREAS, the PNRI Administrative Order No. 01 Series of 2017, "Extending the Validity Period of Radioactive Material Licenses", provides to extend the validity period of Radioactive Material License issued for a period of three (3) or five (5) years: provided, however, that the PNRI in its discretion may limit the period of validity to less than three (3) or five (5) years if the licensee was found to have recurring non-compliance(s) with safety and security implication(s).

Whereas, Executive Order No. 197, s. 2000 of the Office of the President and as implemented by DOF-DBM-NEDA Joint Circular No. 1-2013 (January 30, 2013) – Implementing Rules and Regulations of Administrative Order No. 31, Series of 2012, on the Rationalization of Rates of Fees and Charges, Increase in Existing Rates, and Imposition of New Fees and Charges and DOST Administrative Order No. 001, Series of 2014, have authorized all government agencies to increase their collection of fees and charges for services rendered in order to help the government meet its present budgetary deficit;

WHEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested on PNRI under Section 4(k) of Republic Act No. 5207, as amended, the Philippine Nuclear Research Institute hereby amends Section 6 of CPR Part 22, rev. 2, Schedule of Fees for Radioactive Materials License and Section 3(j), Authority to Transport Fee in accordance with the new validity period of the license.

Section 1. New Schedule of Fees for Radioactive Material License with Extended Validity Period without an Authorization to Transport

Section 3. Validity of 1-year Period.

License Fee corresponding to the different practices with a validity of 1-year period as stipulated under CPR Part 22 rev.2 shall be retained.

Section 4. Amendment of Section 3 (j) Authority to Transport Fee.

The Authority to Transport is hereby amended as follows:

Permit to Transport Fee. A fee of PhP500.00 shall be collected for the issuance of a Permit to Transport from PNRI license holders that are not frequently transporting radioactive material thus their licenses have no specific authorization to transport.

Section 11 of CPR Part 4, rev. 2, Regulations for the Safe Transport of Radioactive Material in the Philippines states that any shipment to be made by a PNRI license-holder not specifically authorized in his radioactive material license or by a non-PNRI licensed consignor to transport any radioactive material shall secure a **Permit to Transport** from PNRI.

Section 5. Authorization to Transport Radioactive Materials for Atomic Energy Facility License.

- a. Licensees that dispense/transfer radioactive materials only for its own use shall be issued a license incorporating an authorization to transport radioactive materials in its Atomic Energy Facility License.
- b. Licensees that dispense/sell/transfer radioactive materials to other PNRI license holders shall be issued a license incorporating authorization to transport radioactive material in its Radioactive Material License for Dispensing.


Section 6. Failure of the Applicant to Pay Prescribed Fees.

Failure of the applicant/licensee to pay the license fees prescribed in this Administrative Order will be a cause to delay any action on the license application. Accordingly, the licensee/applicant is notified about any regulatory action by PNRI.

Section 7. Effectivity.

This Order shall take effect fifteen (15) calendar days following its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
